CALIFORNIA AND COUNTY COVID UPDATES

- Governor Newsome announced on Tuesday, April 6th, that the Blueprint for a Safer Economy will end on JUNE 15, 2021 if vaccine supply and hospitalization rates meet expected conditions:
 - Most capacity limits will be lifted
 - Focus will be on vaccination and common-sense health measures like the continued usage of masks
 - Vaccine eligibility move to 16 and older as of April 15th
 - Riverside County is Currently in the Moderate Orange Tier with all metrics continuing to move toward the Minimal – Yellow Tier
 - Updated CALOSHA guidelines for higher education expected soon with guidance for operations Beyond the Blueprint for a Safer Economy


CLARIFICATIONS BASED ON MARCH 24 COLLEGE CONVERSATION

- Fall 2021 Class Schedule will have approximately 80% of all classes offered in a traditional format. This means the classes will be fully on-campus and in-person. The remaining 20% of classes will either be fully online or hybrid classes (partially on-campus and partially online).
- A contingency schedule of classes for Fall 2021 will be developed that shifts more class sections to fully online if COVID-19 restrictions for higher education keep capacity limits on classrooms and meeting spaces, or 6-foot distancing requirements are in effect.





SAFETY SUPPLIES, EQUIPMENT, AND SIGNAGE
